My main topic of research for 2006-2007 is related to the Millennium Development Goals, especially the third one "Promote gender equality and empower women" with a particular attention to ICTs, in relation with the WSIS Tunis Agenda and Plan of action. I prepare an international conference, Millennia 2008 (www.Millennia2015.org will soon be online), that will be organised by the Destree Institute in March 2008, to deal with those questions on a really international high level.
